### Accessibility

The Van Gogh Museum offers excellent accessibility for visitors using a wheelchair or walking aid. All floors of the museum are easy to reach using the lift. Wheelchairs, walking frames and foldable seats are also available in the museum. Our staff at the information desk will be pleased to assist you.



### Multimedia Desk

Step into the world of Van Gogh and get the full museum experience with our prizewinning multimedia guide. The guide is available in: Dutch, English, French, German, Spanish, Italian, Russian, Japanese, Chinese (Mandarin) and Portuguese. Price: €5 (adults) or €3 (visitors aged 13 to 17).



### Museum Shop

The museum shop in the glass Entrance Building has a wide assortment of gifts and souvenirs. Among other things here you will find scarves, leatherwork, reproductions, jewellery, clothing, toys, painting items, books and postcards. At the service desk in the shop, you can arrange to have your purchases delivered anywhere in the world. ### Bookshop

Our extensive bookshop is on the 3rd floor of the Main Building. Here you will find books about Van Gogh's life and work, the museum collection and the art of his time. For children, there's a special kids' book corner. The bookshop also has a reading table with a lovely view overlooking the Museumplein.

### Information Desk

### Lectures

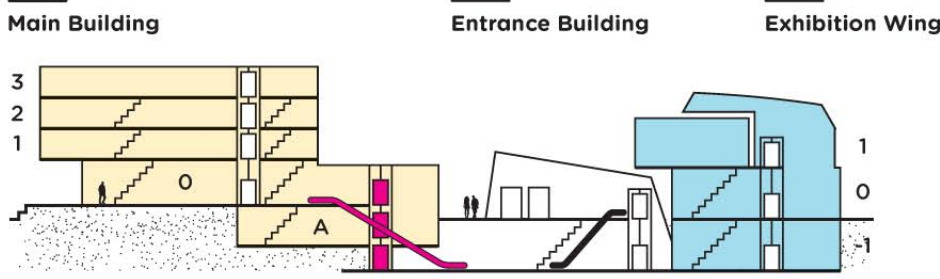

### Van Gogh Museum, Amsterdam

The museum consists of two buildings: the Main Building (yellow) and the Exhibition Wing (blue). These buildings are connected by the glass Entrance Building (white). The Main Building houses the museum's permanent collection with works by Van Gogh and his contemporaries. The Exhibition Wing hosts various exhibitions which are organised there. The Van Gogh Museum is open 365 days a year.

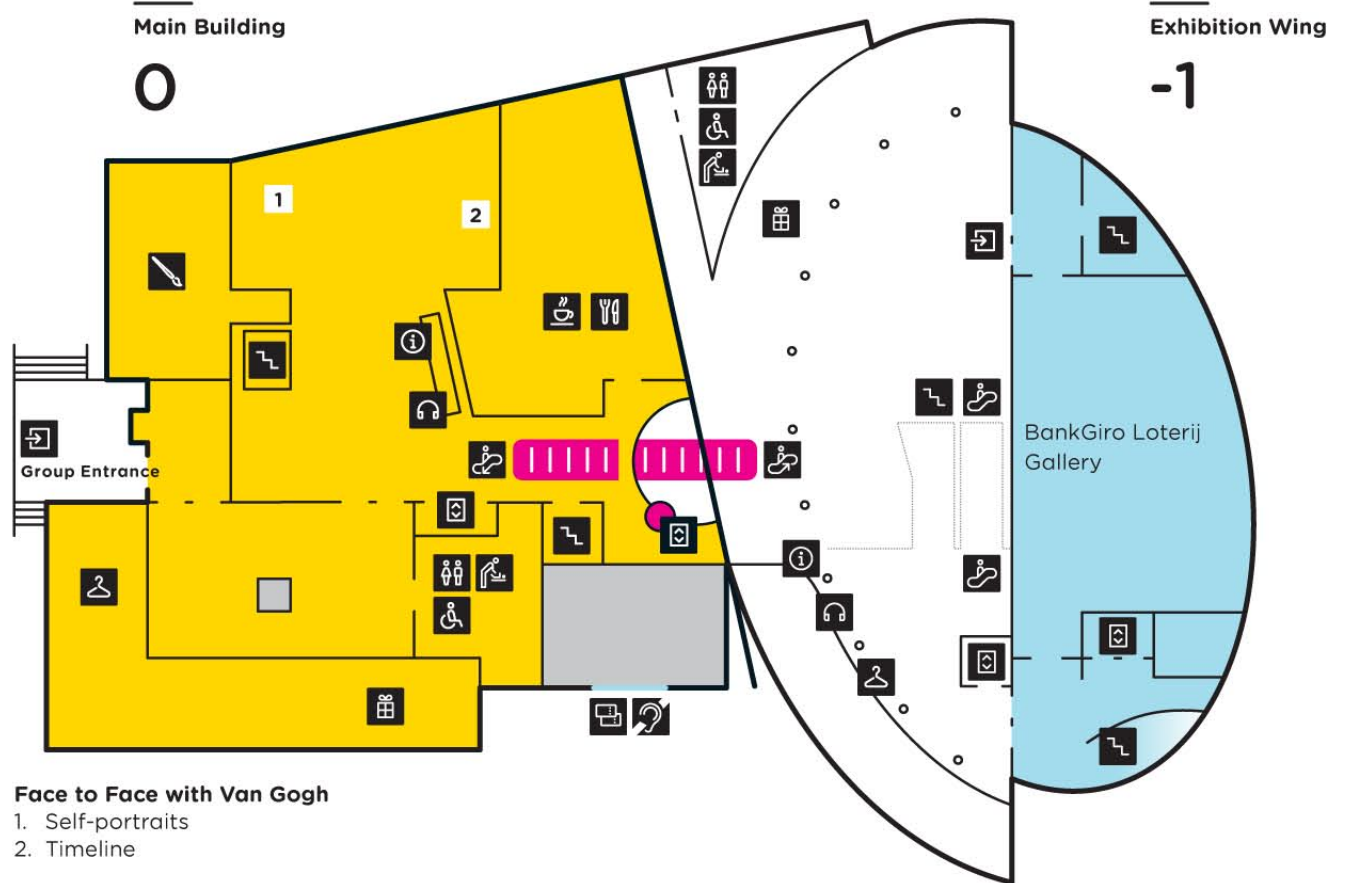
